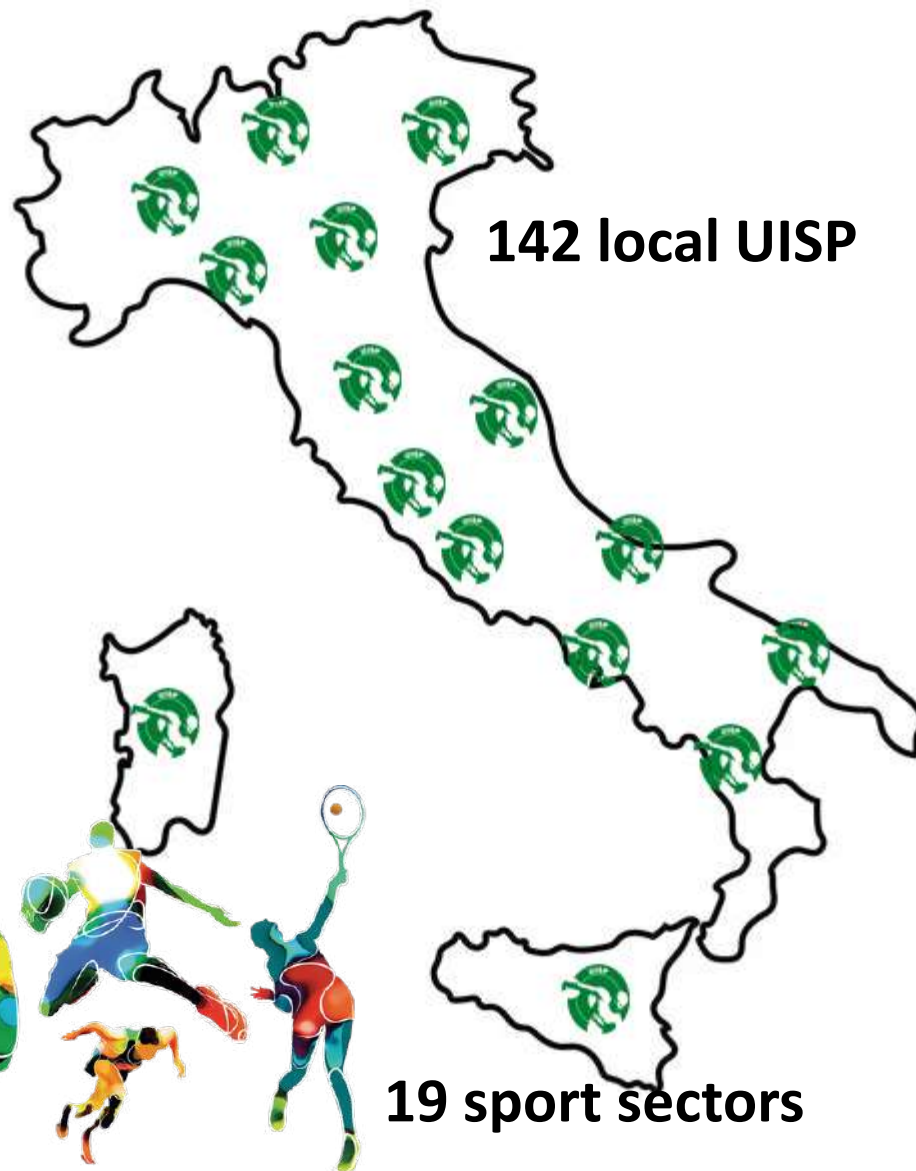

Knowledge and Networking



Project aims to develop a common methodology for the monitoring, prevention and mediation of discrimination in sports venues, based on the role that grassroots sport can play in addressing discrimination and supporting victims.

Sports venues are frequented by many potential victims of discrimination (based on origin, religion, skin colour, etc.) and many discriminatory acts take place in the sport world.

As the phenomenon of discrimination is 'under-reported', many victims do not receive support and no mediation action is taken. Sports and other professionals can play an important role (as 'Sentinels' of discrimination) in monitoring the phenomenon, supporting victims and implementing conflict mediation actions.
